



CHIPPEWA COUNTY VACANCY NOTICE: Chippewa County Economic Development Corporation

The Chippewa County Board of Commissioners seeks to appoint one Chippewa County individual to the Chippewa County Economic Development Corporation to fill a vacancy that will expire on March 31, 2028. The Chippewa County Economic Development Corporation's mission is to encourage economic growth through strengthening the county's competitive position and facilitating investments that build capacity, create jobs, generate economic opportunity, and improve quality of life. Chippewa County EDC was formed under the provisions of Michigan Statutes for the purpose of promoting the economic development of Chippewa County. This is a nine (9) member Board of Directors that serve six (6) year terms.
