



## CHIPPEWA COUNTY VACANCY NOTICES:

The Chippewa County Board of Commissioners seeks to appoint individuals to the following Boards:

- **Building Code Board of Appeals** – 3 appointments – meets as needed – term runs 1-1-2025 until 12-31-2027
  - The Building Code Board of Appeals meets when an interested person would like to appeal a decision of the enforcing officer (building official). Per MCL 125.1351 to 125.1356
- **Department of Health & Human Services** – 1 appointment – meets 1<sup>st</sup> Thursday of the month – the term will be 11-1-2025 until 10-31-2028
  - The County Department of Social Services is a state-administered agency responsible for providing a wide array of financial assistance and social services to county citizens.
- **Department of Veterans Affairs** – 1 appointment – meet last Tuesday of the month- the appointment will be 4-1-2025 until 3-31-2029
  - The Department of Veterans Affairs was established by the Chippewa County Board of Commissioners pursuant to the provision of Public Act 192 of the Public Act of 1953, effective April 1, 1990. The power, duties and assets of the Chippewa County Soldiers Relief Commission were transferred to the Department on April 1, 1990.

- **E 9-1-1 Chippewa County Central Dispatch** – Citizen Position – 1 appointment – meets every other month the last Monday – the term runs 1-1-2025 until 12-31-2027
  - The E 9-1-1 Central Dispatch Board of Directors is established with the intent of this policy board to obtain jurisdiction representation and make recommendations to the Board of Commissioners regarding: fiscal, equipment, personnel needs and assist in negotiations between the municipalities.
  
- **Chippewa County Economic Development Corporation** – 1 appointment – monthly meetings – term effective 4-1-2025 until 3-31-2031
  - The EDC of Chippewa County mission is to encourage economic growth through strengthening the county’s competitive position and facilitating investments that build capacity, create job, generate economic opportunity, and improve quality of life. The Corporation has a nine-member Board of Directors with staff services provided by the corporation.
  
- **EUP Transportation Authority** – 1 appointment – meets 1<sup>st</sup> Tuesday of the month – the term of appointment runs 1-1-2025 until 12-31-2027
  - The EUP Transportation Authority provides transportation, i.e., busing, ferry service, etc. to residents of the Counties of Chippewa and Luce. The five-member Board of Directors are appointed by their respective Board of Commissioners with three representing Chippewa County and two representing Luce County.
  
- **Hiawatha Behavioral Health Authority** – 1 appointment – varies depending on assignments once appointment (minimum is monthly) - term effective 4-1-2025 until 3-31-2028
  - The twelve-member board consists of four appointees from the Counties of Chippewa, Mackinac, and Schoolcraft. The purpose of the HBH Authority is to assist citizens of the three counties dealing with emotional and psychological stress.

- **Road Commission** – 1 appointment – meets every other Thursday - the term runs 1-1-2025 until 12-31-2030
  - The Road Commission is comprised of three members appointed for six-year terms, and have the responsibilities including construction and maintenance of County roads and bridges and the administration of funds allocated from gas and weight taxes.
  
- **U.P. State Fair Authority** – 1 appointment – varies – the term of appointment 1-1-2025 until 12-31-2027
  - The U.P. State Fair Authority is responsible for coordinating and providing a variety of services related to the U.P. State Fair and the fairgrounds for the citizens of the Upper Peninsula.
