I. PROCEDURAL GUIDELINES

- A.** If during any medical intake screening and/or classification assessment an ICE detainee indicates they have experienced sexual victimization or perpetrated sexual abuse, staff will immediately refer the detainee to Health Services.
- B.** When a referral for medical follow-up is initiated, the detainee shall receive a health evaluation no later than two (2) working days from the date of the assessment.
- C.** When a referral for mental health follow-up is initiated, the detainee shall receive a mental health evaluation no later than seventy-two (72) hours after the referral.
