I. PROCEDURAL GUIDELINES

- A.** The Chippewa County Correctional Facility shall offer medical and mental health evaluations and, as appropriate, treatment to all inmate/detainees who have been victimized by sexual abuse and/or assault while incarcerated to include treatment plans, follow-up services, and when necessary, referrals for continued care following a transfer or placement in another facility.
- B.** Victims will be provided medical and mental health services consistent with the community level of care.
- C.** Victims of sexual assault and/or abuse while in custody shall be offered testing for sexually transmitted infections as medically appropriate.
- D.** Any female inmate/detainee that is sexually abused and/or assaulted (vaginal penetration by a male abuser) shall be offered a pregnancy test. If a pregnancy results from a sexual assault, the victim shall receive timely and comprehensive information/access to lawful pregnancy-related medical services.
- E.** The Chippewa County Correctional Facility shall attempt to conduct a mental health evaluation of all know detainee-on-detainee abusers within sixty (60) days of learning such abuse history and offer treatment when deemed appropriate by mental health services.
