AMBULANCE AND FIRE PROTECTION PROPOSITION MILLAGE RENEWAL

(This proposal will permit the County to restore and continue the millage previously approved by the electors in 2010)

Shall the expired previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution on general ad valorem taxes within Chippewa County, Michigan of .4280 mill (\$0.4280 per \$1,000 of taxable value) which was reduced to .4275 mill by the required millage rollbacks, be renewed at .4275 mill (\$0.4275 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for 4 years, being 2014, 2015, 2016, and 2017, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for the public services of Ambulance and Fire Protection county-wide with the provision that the levy be disbursed in the following manner: 35% administration, training, and communications operations, and 65% to be disbursed annually pro-rata based on Taxable Valuations to the City of Sault Ste. Marie and the Townships of Chippewa County, Michigan? The estimate of the revenue the County will collect if this millage is approved and levied in 2014 is \$475,000.
